Wayne Hansard was the director of Morristown Parks and Recreation for thirty three years. He was responsible for development of numerous Parks and Recreation facilities in Morristown and Hamblin County including Frank Lorino Park, Cherokee Park and Miller Park.

SUBMISSION FORMAT: Application packet must include the following for consideration:

Narrative:

- Nominee must be employed by a TRPA Agency Member department.
- Nominee must be a current TRPA member in good standing.
- Nominations must be submitted based upon programs or projects initiated and conducted during the current award year (past 12 months).
- Selection will be based on the program's innovation and the extent to which it helped better serve its constituency.

Narratives must be a maximum of four (4) pages using the following formatting requirements:

- Double spaced
- Margins on narrow setting (.50 on all sides)
- Font size is Times New Roman, size 12
- Ink color is black
- All narratives must include a header and footer with the following:
 - Header – use three column format with the agency name on the left, project title in the center and this year on the right.
 - Footer – use center format with the page number.
- Include a headshot in jpg format.
